



Dear Men,

March 1, 2009

February was a monumental month for The King's Men (TKM) apostolate. During this month three major events took place: Coyotes Show Club officially shut down, the Night for Life benefit at Trenton Country Club was a huge success and our Into the Wild program was launched.

On Saturday February 7<sup>th</sup>, I received a phone call from a journalist from *The Intelligencer* newspaper with the news that Coyotes Show Club was going to permanently close their doors as of that night. This was very exciting news, but given our past experiences with this sexually oriented business (SOB), co-founder Damian Wargo and I were quick to temper ourselves. Despite our lack of confirmation about the closing, I traveled at midnight to film the last documented night of Coyotes' unlawful operation. As some of you know, we have been documenting our activism this past year against Coyotes in an effort to capture on video material for a proposed future documentary on TKM's No More Porn Tour. TKM is cooperating with Anthony Buono of Ave Maria Singles to develop this documentary. Please stay tuned to these updates for future news about this project.

On Monday February 9<sup>th</sup>, TKM confirmed that the SOB that we have been fighting since February 2008 was in fact no longer in business. Despite our jubilation over the news, TKM was still cautiously optimistic in anticipation of the sheriff's sale scheduled for Friday February 13<sup>th</sup> in Doylestown, PA. Our fear was that another SOB would be interested in purchasing the property. Thankfully, Univest Bank bought back the property for a modest 1.9 million. No buyers were willing to bid on the property so the bank which originally wrote the note for the Coyotes business owners once again assumed control of the property—Praise God!

Since November 2008, Damian and I have been planning a benefit in partnership with The Bucks County Community Women's Center (BCCWC) on Saturday February 28<sup>th</sup>. TKM and BCCWC board members worked extremely hard to bring together approximately 180 people for what we called a "Night for Life" at the Trenton Country Club in Ewing, NJ. The proceeds of this benefit were 100% for the missions of TKM and BCCWC. The name "Night for Life" was coined by Bucks County pro-life leader Bill Miller. The theme for the evening could not have been more appropriate as both organizations are doing literally life saving work. BCCWC is a new crisis pregnancy center located in Bristol, PA and in less than one year of work, 5 babies have been saved from the tragedy of abortion. TKM as you know is actively fighting the multi-billion pornography industry and continues to offer men healing and hope from this deadly vice destroying marriages, damaging children and hurting families.

Finally, Damian has been working very diligently to put together an exciting program for men that I believe will truly lift them to a new level of growth in their masculinity. The program is called **Into the Wild**. This outdoor experiential program for men is scheduled to take place on the rugged and beautiful state game lands of French Creek Park in Elverson, PA on the weekend of June 4-7<sup>th</sup>.
